Members present: President Franz Schmitz, Commissioners Ken Schneider and Jason Meyer. Also present: Recording Secretary Brenda Schneider.

- 1. Call to order. President Schmitz called the meeting to order at 5:04 p.m.
- 2. <u>Approval of the minutes of the 9/5/2024 meeting</u>. Motion by Jason Meyer, second by Ken Schneider, to approve the minutes of the September 5<sup>th</sup> monthly meeting as distributed. Motion carried (3-0).
- 3. <u>Discussion and possible action regarding operational issues:</u>
  - a. Meter station. Nothing to report at this time.
  - b. <u>Lift Stations</u>. The September pump runtime reports were reviewed. A small spike was noted on 9/8/24.

On September 16, the County Q station ceased recording flow information. Joel Schneider contacted Missions. The SIM card is bad. Missions will mail a new card.

Missions informed the district their legacy units are failing. They plan to retro-fit an upgrade. The cost of said upgrade is \$2050.00 for each station. Consideration was postponed to the next meeting. Brenda will contact Sabel Mechanical regarding a different service that was recently installed in Taycheedah Sanitary District No. 3's grinder stations.

- c. <u>Grinder pump stations</u>. The alarms at the Welter house have been going off. Upon checking the station, all seems fine.
- d. <u>Clearwater Inspections</u>. Joel Schneider will met with John Rickert for manhole inspection training. He needs a hook. John Rickert will check the inventory at the Taycheedah Town Hall.
- e. Other operational issues. The Annual OSG meeting was recently conducted. The City's five-year CIP projects estimate the District's share at \$192,644.00. The City plans to fund the projects with a 10-year and 20-year revenue bonding. Payment plans have yet to be distributed.
- 4. <u>Approval of District bills</u>. Motion by Ken Schneider, second by Jason Meyer, to approve the bills (order #64-69), for a total of \$1,797.90, and to authorize the following:
  - Acknowledge the quarterly debt payment of \$9,124.99 to Bank First. Motion carried (3-0).
- 5. <u>Schedule the next meeting</u>. The next monthly meeting of the Commission is tentatively scheduled for Thursday November 14<sup>th</sup>, at 5:00 p.m. The Joint meeting will be on October 31<sup>st</sup> at the Taycheedah Town Hall.
