**Closed Session:**

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Consideration and possible action to enter into Closed Session, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §19.85(1)(g), for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel for the town who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the Town with respect to litigation in which the Town is or is likely to become involved; and pursuant to Wis. Stat 19.85(1)€ for the purpose of deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session.

Subject: During this closed session, the Board will discuss the Town's EMS proposals/contracts received.

Motion by roll call vote to enter Closed Session at 7:01 p.m.

Motion by roll call vote to reconvene into open session at 7:45 p.m.

Chairman Steffes shared with everyone in attendance the reason for this meeting is due to the City of Fond du Lac Ambulance wanting the Town of Taycheedah to contract the remaining 2025 year AND to include 2026. During the closed session both options were discussed. Supervisor Tim Simon shared the following information with all attendees; talks with Orange Cross were productive. No subsidy for Municipalities as this is covered by their run rates and special events. Mt. Calvary's run totals and receivables are not balancing as it appears to have an undervalue of approximately \$200,000.00. According to representatives in attendance they said rates are negotiated and they do not bill balances owed. Discussions and questions arose why this is happening.


Motioned by Tim Simon, second by Justin Fowler to pay Mt. Calvary the balance owed for 2025 (\$21,299.30) and contract with Mt. Calvary in 2026 (\$224,796.00) Motion carried (3-1).
