Members present: Commissioners Brian Mand and Mark Haensgen. Also present: Recording Secretary Brenda Schneider and John Rickert, Maintenance Technician. Excused: President Katherine Diederich

Call to order. Commissioner Mand called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance. The Commission dispensed with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the minutes of the 8/20/25 and 1/15/26 monthly meetings. The minutes of the August 20th are not yet prepared. Motion by Mark Haensgen, second by Brian Mand, to approve the minutes of the January 15th meeting as distributed. Motion carried (2-0).

- d. Clearwater elimination. John Rickert requests a letter to the homeowners be included with the April billing.
- e. Other maintenance and operational issues. Nothing to report at this time.

Unfinished Business:

1. Discussion and possible authorization to renew a maturing investment. The CD at Fox Valley matures on February 15th. Motion by Brian Mand, second by Mark Haensgen, to reinvest the funds in a CD for a period of seven months at a rate of 3.63%. Motion carried (2-0).
