February 9, 2026

Members present: Chairman Ken Steffes, Supervisors James Rosenthal II, Justin Fowler and Tim Simon. Also present: Clerk Kristin Marcoe and Park/Road Maintenance Manager Randy Rieder. Absent: Treasurer Katherine Diederich

Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance:

Chairman Steffes called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of Meeting Minutes:

Motioned by James Rosenthal II, second by Tim Simon to approve the minutes of the January 12, 2026, monthly board meeting. Motion carried (4-0).

Reports:

Park & Rec. Advisory Council: Randy Rieder informed the board the Snowbol event in Kiekhaefer Park had approximately 204 antique sleds. The weather was ideal and brought in a good turnout of people. As always, the grounds were cleaned up after the event.

Road Department Managers Report: Randy Rieder informed the board they are busy plowing the roads and clearing snow drifts. cleaning roads.

Review Financial Reports:

Treasurer Katherine Diederich was absent. The tax collecting has been completed and the January settlement was finalized. Three large invoices consisting of Calumet and Mt. Calvary Fire Department along with Mt. Calvary Ambulance. There is adequate cash to pay the January invoices.

Approval of Town Bills:

Motioned by Justin Fowler, second by Tim Simon to approve the bills (order #1-26). Motion carried (4-0).

New Business:

1. Operator's Licenses: Four (4) applications were received for approval. Motioned by Tim Simon, second by James Rosenthal II to approve the applications received. Motion carried (4-0).
2. Lions Club: St. Peters Lion Club approached the board inquiring the use of the town hall to hold their monthly meetings. Meetings are on the 4th Wednesday of each month, beginning at 6:00 p.m. and done by 9:00 p.m. The only conflict would be election months as equipment is tested on Wednesday evenings. The club will take this in consideration as they are currently in the process of finding alternative locations for their meetings. Motioned by Chairman Steffes, second by Justin Fowler to approve St. Peters Lion Club the use of the town hall for their monthly meetings. Motion carried (4-0).
3. Leaf Burning Discussion: A letter was received by Terri and Jeff Lottes with concerns about burning leaves in the fall. Lottes asked in the letter if the town could ban burning. Suggesting residents bag leaves/grass, mow/mulch and/or compost. Lottes informed the Treasurer they

would attend the meeting but were not in attendance. Brief discussion by the board regarding burning and talking to your neighbors. The board is not acting on this letter and burning in the town is allowed.

4. Town Board Meeting Rescheduled: March 9, 2026, meeting will be rescheduled to Monday, March 16, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.
5. District 12 Candidate Jim Sippel: Jim Sippel, candidate for District 12, was scheduled to speak briefly at the meeting to introduce himself and answer any questions. Mr. Sippel was unable to attend our meeting.

2. Jason Guelig: Plan Commission Hearing held on February 9, 2026, to rezone. Motioned by Justin Fowler, second by James Rosenthal II to approve the recommendation from the Plan Commission to rezone. Motion carried (3-0-1). Tim Simon abstained.


